This is a 35hr/week paid internship with an expected start date of September 25, 2017.

The intern's responsibilities include:

- Working closely with the iBiology team on video production pipelines, including editing slides, overseeing video editing, and writing associated web content and educational materials to accompany talks.
- Developing, organizing, and executing current and new initiatives that support the mission of iBiology.

- Ph.D. in the biological sciences (preferred but not required; senior graduate students are welcome to apply).
- Experience and/or demonstrated passion for science communication and education.
- Superb presentation and written communication skills; ability to be creative and engaging in various forms of communication.
- Well organized, detailed oriented and able to prioritize and execute multiple projects simultaneously.
- Must be eligible to work in the United States.
